Dear Interested Parties,

B&R Machine has established a counterfeit parts prevention program in keeping with AS9100 Revision D to ensure counterfeit parts do not enter our supply chain.

A counterfeit part is an unauthorized copy, imitation, substitute, or modified part (e.g., material, part, component), which is knowingly misrepresented as a specified genuine part of an original or authorized manufacturer.

Examples of a counterfeit part can include, but are not limited to, the false identification of marking or labeling, grade, serial number, date code, documentation, or performance characteristics. – B&R Quality Manual, Rev A, Sec. 3.1.

By developing approved suppliers and monitoring special process vendors, B&R Machine Inc. can mitigate risks associated with counterfeit parts entering our supply chain. Moreover, through the establishment of robust quality system controls, B&R ensures the authenticity of purchased materials, parts, and services.
